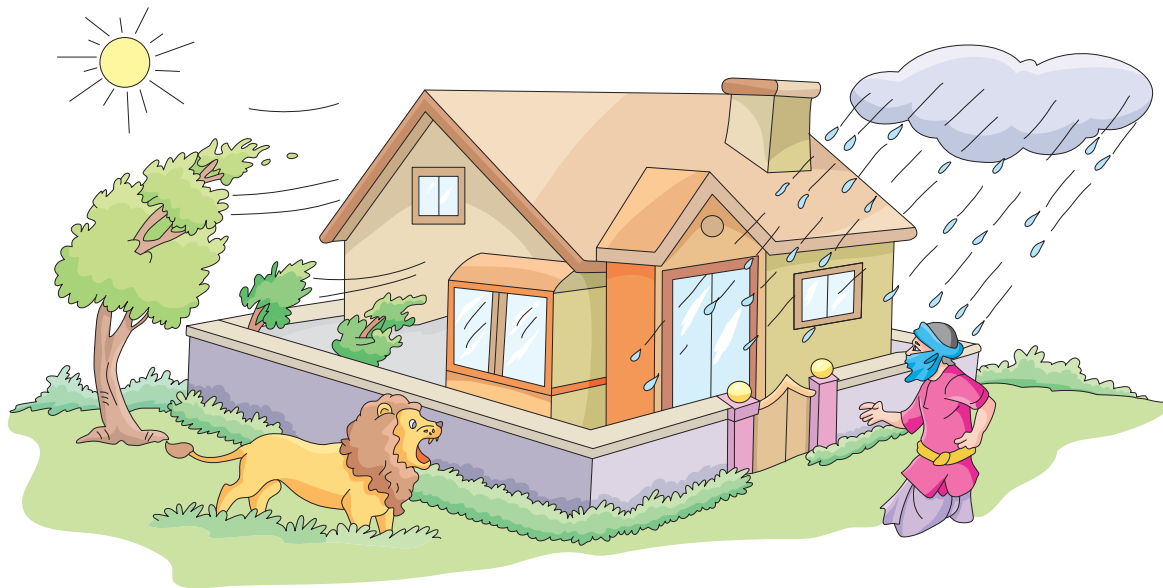

## My House

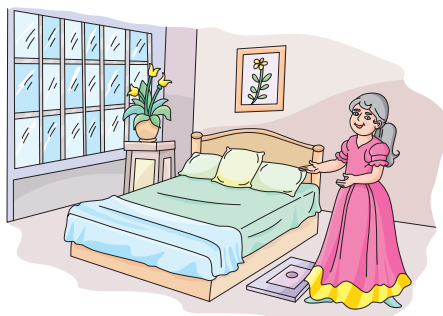


A house is a place where we keep ourselves **safe** from heat, rain and **cold**. It also **saves** us from **thieves** and wild **animals**.



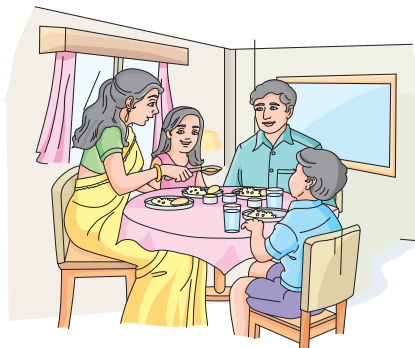
All of us need a house to live in. A house in which a family lives is called a **home**.

We sleep in the bedroom.



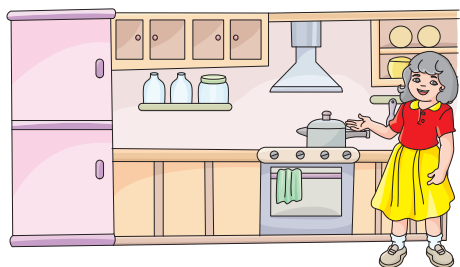
### DINING ROOM

We take bath in the bathroom.



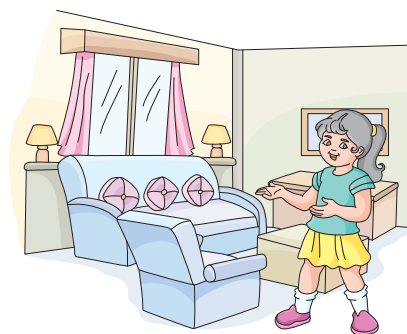
### KITCHEN
