3. In Order to Survive

An adaptation is a special skill which helps an animal to survive and do everything it needs to do. Animals depend on their physical features to help them obtain food, build home to keep safe and resist weather. **Given below are some adaptations, read the clues and identify the animals.**



1. This animal uses its trunk to drink water, gather food and bathe. It also uses its tusks to protect itself.



2. This animal lives in family groups because they are weak alone. They have stripes to recognize each other.



3. When it spots a meal, it flicks its long and sticky tongue to it. The tongue sticks to the meal and pulls it back to the mouth.



4. These are flightless birds and also great swimmers. Their webbed feet and streamlined bodies help them swim in water better.

5. This animal has such white fur that matches the colour of snow. It can camouflage in ice and snow. Its skin is black to absorb heat from sun rays and keep it warm.



6. This animal can tolerate extreme temperatures which means both cold and hot. It stores food and water in its two humps for 3 to 4 days.
